PEITION CIRCULATORS, NOTARIES LIST, AND CIRCULATOR REQUIREMENTS
 (C.R.S. § 1-4-905(5))

A candidate or committee shall maintain a list of the names and addresses of all circulators who circulated petition sections on behalf of the candidate, the notaries public who notarized petition sections on behalf of the candidate, and the petition section numbers that each circulator circulated and that each notary public notarized. C.R.S. § 1-4-905(5)

Circulator Requirements:

- Circulators who are not paid for circulating a petition must display an identification badge that includes the words "VOLUNTEER CIRCULATOR" in bold-faced type that is clearly legible. C.R.S. § 1-4-905(6)(a)
- Circulators who are paid to circulate petitions must display an identification badge that includes the words "PAID CIRCULATOR" in bold-faced type that is clearly legible, and the name and telephone number of the individual employing the circulator. C.R.S. § 1-4-905(6)(b)
- The Secretary of State provides training for volunteer and paid circulators. Candidates and committees must inform their petition circulators of the availability of the training program as one manner of complying with the requirement in the circulator's affidavit that the circulator read and understand the laws pertaining to petition circulation. C.R.S. § 1-4-905(7)
- A copy of this list must be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder when the signed petitions are filed. If a copy of the list is not filed, the Clerk and Recorder must prepare the list from the information contained in the completed petition and charge the candidate a fee to cover the actual cost of preparing the list. Cost will be based on hourly wage plus benefits by the quarter hour. Once filed or prepared, the list is a public record for purposes of the Colorado Open Records Act. C.R.S. § 1-4-905(5)
