Statement Regarding Sale of Dominion Voting Systems

On Thursday, October 9, it was announced that Dominion Voting Systems was acquired by Liberty Vote, a private company.

Pitkin County is one of 60 (of 64) counties in Colorado that contract with Dominion for our voting system technology. There was no advance notification to the clerks of these counties prior to the sale. However, Scott Leiendecker, the owner and CEO of Liberty Vote attended a Colorado County Clerks Association meeting on October 13 to answer questions and concerns.

In Colorado, under the direction of the Secretary of State's office, we have multiple layers of security for our voting systems, including pre-election testing and post-election audits. All of this will remain the same.

While no concerning changes have been proposed at this time, I, along with the other Colorado County Clerks and the Colorado Secretary of State's office, will remain vigilant should there be any proposed changes in the future that might be of concern.
