



## STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

April 20, 2018

On April 19, 2018, Deborah J Bamesberger, Democratic candidate for Pitkin County Assessor, submitted petition signatures to the Pitkin County Clerk and Recorder to cure their previously insufficient candidate petition. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 26, 2018 primary election ballot. Under the Pitkin County Home Rule Charter, Deborah J Bamesberger's petitions must contain at least 100 valid signatures.



<sup>1</sup> Article 6 of the Pitkin County Home Rule Charter specifies that "Where there are more than two (2) persons standing for election to a given office, all such persons shall have their names placed on a ballot which shall be voted upon at the same time and place as the regular primary elections." In the event of two (2) or less persons standing for election, "County elections shall be held at the time of the general election." The 2018 General Election will be held on November 6, 2018.
