
On April 18, 2018, Kelly McNicholas Kury, Democratic candidate for Pitkin County Commissioner District 2, submitted 214 petition signatures to the Pitkin County Clerk and Recorder. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 26, 2018 primary election ballot. Under the Pitkin County Home Rule Charter, Kelly McNicholas Kury’s petitions must contain at least 100 valid signatures.

Petition Verification Summary

Number of qualified signatures submitted	214
Number of entries rejected	38
Number of entries accepted	176
Number of valid signatures required	100

The Pitkin County Clerk and Recorder has determined that Kelly McNicholas Kury submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures and will be placed on the 2018 primary election ballot¹. A public record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Pitkin County Clerk and Recorder’s office.

¹ Article 6 of the Pitkin County Home Rule Charter specifies that “Where there are more than two (2) persons standing for election to a given office, all such persons shall have their names placed on a ballot which shall be voted upon at the same time and place as the regular primary elections.” In the event of two (2) or less persons standing for election, “County elections shall be held at the time of the general election.” The 2018 General Election will be held on November 6, 2018.
